The admissions packet consists of:

- 1) An application form, and
- 2) A two page statement of intent indicating how this degree will benefit you.
- 3) An unofficial copy of your UNM transcript and, if appropriate, transfer evaluation from Loboweb.

Students must have at least a 2.5 GPA. Applicants are required to be taking or have taken either CRP 165 (Introduction to Planning) or CRP 181 (Introduction to Environmental Problems) at the time of their application.
