**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

Applicant must be in good academic standing – must maintain a graduate coursework GPA of 3.0 or higher.

A selected applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours of graduate coursework during each semester in which a PA-ship is held for fall and spring contracts.

A selected applicant may not accept additional UNM employment that causes total hours worked for UNM to exceed 30 hours per week during fall and spring semesters.

Compensation for these PA positions includes \$12.00 per hour for 10 hours of work per week, plus health insurance for the semester (see OGS guidelines for more information). For out-of-state students, an assistantship also garners in-state tuition for the semester(s) during which the assistantship is held.
