

The Master of Landscape Architecture program is a fully accredited graduate professional degree that prepares graduates to enter the profession and discipline of landscape architecture. The MLA degree program accepts applications from students with previous degrees in non-design and design disciplines. The SA•P does not offer an undergraduate degree in Landscape Architecture, but does offer an undergraduate concentration.

### Students with Non-Design Degrees

Students entering the program with non-design majors are required to complete a minimum of 87 credit hours. This will normally require three-years

### **Students with Design Degrees**

Students entering the program with degrees in Landscape Architecture, Architecture or related environmental design disciplines are normally required to complete a two year program comprising 48 - 54 credit hours, with the total number of credit hours to be determined by the Program Director on a case-by-case basis.

### Post Professional Students

The Post Professional Degree program is offered for applicants who hold a Bachelor degree in Landscape Architecture, who are licensed or who qualify for licensure and who have significant experience in the profession.
